The South Dakota State Railroad Museum is proud to announce its participation in the Black Hills Hobby Expo on Saturday, March 23rd from 10:00AM to 4:00PM at the General Beadle Elementary School in Rapid City.

The public is encouraged to bring model trains and railroad related items to the Railroad Museum's table to show and learn more about their item's history.
